Section 1 Intended Use

INTENDED USE

The SelectProtectTM is a safety enhancement system intended to aid in the reduction of patient falls and increase bed-bound safety. It is intended to be used without bed side rails. The SelectProtect is designed to be integrated only with ROHO® SelectAir® Low Air Loss Mattress Replacement Systems ("SelectAir") using SelectAir mattress replacements listed in the Product Specifications section, a mattress pad, and either a SelectAir Control Unit or SelectAir Max® Control Unit. Use of the SelectProtect should be determined based upon facility protocols, applicable laws, regulations, guidelines and individual user safety considerations. It does not replace the need for patient fall prevention measures.

The *Select*Protect is intended for patients that weigh 75 to 400 lbs., the same weight limit established for the applicable Standard *Select*Air and *Select*Air Max Mattress Replacement Systems.

CLINICIAN CONSULTATION: ROHO, Inc. recommends that a clinician be consulted to determine if the *Select*Protect is appropriate for the patient's particular needs.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS

The *Select*Protect is not a restraint device. It is not designed to limit the patient's movements on the mattress or restrict the caregiver's access to the patient.

Section 2

Warnings and Cautions



SUFFOCATION RISK: The *Select*Protect must not be used by infants or other people who are at risk of suffocation. To reduce the risk of suffocation:

- Situate patient with head as close to headboard as possible.
- Reposition patient with head as close to headboard as possible upon reclining after upright mode.
- **DO NOT** allow patient to lie on stomach.
- Check on patient at least once a day while using the SelectProtect.

↑ WARNINGS CONTINUED

FALL RISK: Properly trained and knowledgeable care givers should determine whether to use pads, additional bolsters, alarms, high-low beds, or other positioning aids and safety devices that are available on the market to reduce the risk of entrapment or falls. To reduce the risk of falls.

- Ensure patient is properly immersed (Refer to Setup in the *Select*Air Operations Manual). Fall risk increases if patient is not properly immersed, if the mattress is over-inflated, or if the bed is in an upright position.
- Check on patient at least once a day while using the *Select*Protect.

ENTRAPMENT RISK:

 DO NOT use the SelectProtect with bed side rails. This contra-indication supersedes the references to bed side rails currently stated in the *Select*Air Low Air Low Mattress Systems Operations Manual.


- Refer to Safety Precautions and Important Safeguards in the SelectAir Operations Manual, and follow all warnings and instructions marked on the control unit and mattress unless otherwise specified in this manual.
- DO NOT use the SelectProtect with any other manufacturer's products, overlays or other *Select*Air Systems not indicated in the Product Specifications Section.
- **DO NOT** use the *Select*Protect for patients who weigh under 75 lbs. or over 400 lbs.
- **DO NOT** use the *Select*Protect for patients with sporadic, uncontrolled movements. Such patients could accidentally fall from the bed.
- Refer to the *Select*Air Operations Manual for proper setup, care, maintenance of the SelectAir mattress replacement, mattress pad, and control unit.

Prior to setup or removal of the SelectProtect, always:

- Remove the patient from the mattress.
- Turn the SelectAir control unit power entry switch OFF and unplug the power cord per instructions in the *Select*Air Operations Manual.
- Remove all linens, if applicable.

Section 3 Parts Detail

PARTS DETAIL



- **A.** SelectProtect Cover: The one-piece cover is composed of a top and a bottom section with a zipper on each side. The top section positions both the shoulder and foot bolsters in pockets. The bottom section positions the shoulder bolsters. Four straps are located on each side of the bottom section to secure the cover to the bed frame.
- **B. Foot Bolsters:** The two foot bolsters rest within pockets in the top cover section only. The foot bolsters are each marked with an "F" and are interchangeable.
- **C. Shoulder Bolsters:** The two shoulder bolsters are inserted into pockets in the bottom cover section near the patient's shoulder area of the mattress assembly and are encapsulated in the top cover section when the zipper is closed. The shoulder bolsters are each marked with an "S" and are interchangeable.
- **D. Operations Manual:** Instructions on the *Select*Protect setup, removal, care and other important information.

Materials:

The cover top is 100% polyurethane coated polyester which is fluid resistant, anti-microbial and the cover bottom is 100% PVC (DEHP and BPA free) backed polyester. The bolsters are made of polyurethane foam. The bolster covers are nylon.

SETUP & REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

Prior to setup or removal of the SelectProtect, always:


- Remove the patient from the mattress.
- Turn the SelectAir control unit power entry switch OFF and unplug the power cord. Refer
 to the SelectAir Operations Manual for instruction.
- Remove all linens, if applicable.

To combine the *Select*Protect with a *Select*Air System, some disassembly and re-assembly will be required. The original *Select*Air cover will not be used during the integration of the systems. The *Select*Air mattress sheet will not fit the *Select*Protect.

To Integrate the SelectProtect with an existing SelectAir Mattress Replacement System:


- 1. Unzip the existing *Select*Air cover.
- Locate the mattress hose fitting where the air supply hose connects to the mattress. Disconnect the air supply hose from the mattress hose fitting and pass it through the access hole in the cover.
- Remove the SelectAir mattress replacement and mattress pad. Set aside for use with the SelectProtect.
- 4. Unstrap and remove the SelectAir cover.


To set up the *Select*Protect:





Steps 3-4

- 1. Place the *Select*Protect cover on the bed so the air hose access hole is at the foot of the bed.
- Using only one zipper pull, unzip the cover and drape the top section over the foot of the bed frame.
- 3. Place the mattress pad inside the bottom section of the cover.
- 4. Place the *Select*Air mattress replacement on top of the mattress pad with the air inlet fitting positioned at the foot of the bed.












- Locate the SelectAir mattress hose fitting and feed it through the access hole in the bottom of the cover.
- 6. Press the mattress hose fitting into the fitting on the air supply hose.
- 7. Place the top section of the *Select*Protect cover over the mattress.
- 8. At the foot of the mattress, lift one side of the cover's top section until the foot bolster pocket's zipper is visible. The pocket zipper in on the underside of the cover top.
- 9. Unzip the pocket.
- Insert a foot bolster so the tapered end will be facing down and away from the bed.
- 11. Zip the pocket shut.
- 12. Repeat steps 8-11 for the second foot bolster.
- 13. Zip the cover shut unil you reach a shoulder bolster pocket.







- 14. Insert the tapered end of a shoulder bolster into the pocket in the bottom cover section so it will be facing away from the bed.
- Guide the shoulder bolster into the top cover pocket while zipping the pocket shut.
- Repeat steps 13-15 for the second shoulder bolster and then zip the cover closed.

Note: If the *Select*Air mattress replacement has a foot pillow, tuck it into its pocket in the top section of the cover before zipping it shut.

- 17. Secure the safety straps on the bottom cover section to the bed frame.
- Plug in the control unit and turn it on (refer to the SelectAir Operations Manual).
- 19. Transfer the patient onto the bed, positioning head close to the headboard and in line with the opening between the shoulder bolsters and the headboard.
- 20. Refer to the *Select*Air Operations Manual and the control unit for proper inflation for patient.

To Remove the SelectProtect:

- 1. Unzip the cover.
- 2. Partially fold the top section of the cover away to expose the shoulder bolsters.
- 3. Remove the shoulder bolsters from their pockets.
- 4. Unzip the foot bolster pockets and remove the foot bolsters.
- 5. Fold the top section of the *Select*Protect cover toward the foot of the bed.
- 6. Disconnect the *Select*Air mattress replacement hose fitting from the air supply hose.
- 7. Remove the mattress and mattress pad.
- 8. Unstrap the *Select*Protect cover and remove it from the bed.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

Note:

- Cleaning and disinfecting are two different processes. To be effective, cleaning must precede disinfecting.
- The Select Protect must be cleaned, disinfected, and checked for proper functioning between multiple patient use.
- Disassemble the *Select*Protect before cleaning or disinfecting any of its components between patients.

To clean the SelectProtect cover while in use:

Wipe surface with pH neutral soap and warm water. Rinse with water and dry.

To clean SelectProtect cover between patients:

Remove cover from mattress and remove foam bolsters from pockets. Machine wash in warm water. No bleach, Tumble dry low. **DO NOT** use high heat.







To disinfect SelectProtect cover between patients:

Machine wash in hot water (sanitizing cycle). No bleach. Tumble dry low.







Note: Disinfectants are not effective on porous surfaces such as foam. If the foam bolsters become soiled or contaminated, **DO NOT** use. Replacement foam bolsters may be purchased. Replace the foam bolsters with components supplied by ROHO, Inc. only.

For cleaning and disinfecting the *Select*Air mattress replacement, mattress pad, or control unit during use or between patients, refer to the instructions in the *Select*Air Operations Manual.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem:	Action:
A Component of the <i>Select</i> Protect appears flat or misshapen after setup or during use:	 Check to ensure zippers are completely closed. Check for tears or broken seams in pockets. Check to ensure foam bolsters are properly inserted within appropriate pockets. Check for loose components or visible damage to component or assembly.
SelectProtect Assembly looks "uneven" or zippers don't close:	Check to ensure bolsters are properly positioned inside their appropriate pockets.
